Neuropsychology Testing Technician

The neuropsychology testing technician must be fluent in the standardized administration and scoring of a wide range of psychological and neuropsychological tests, establish an appropriate testing environment and administer tests to outpatients, score all tests administered, observe and document relevant patient behaviors, and provide a brief written summary of test results. The testing tech should have computer proficiency with previous experience in word-processing and neuropsychological scoring programs.

The testing tech should be flexible, self-motivated, professional, and possess excellent interpersonal and organizational skills. They must have outstanding written and verbal communication, interpersonal, critical thinking, organizational, assessment and management skills to meet the expected outcomes of the role. The individual must be detailed oriented, take initiative and have professional accountability. They must be able to work independently and within a team environment. Good judgment in rendering safe, ethical and effective patient care is required. This can be either a part-time or full-time position.
